From the School Nurse:

Community acquired methycillin-resistant staphylococcus aureus (CA-MRSA) affects over 90,000 Americans each year. Schools nationwide are reporting outbreaks of MRSA - especially in gyms and locker rooms. What does it look like?

Staph infections generally start as small red bumps which can quickly turn into deep painful abscesses. They can burrow into the body causing potentially life-threatening infections.

How is MRSA transmitted?

Crowding, Skin to skin contact
Compromised skin, shared items
Poor hygiene

Prevention:

Hand washing, showering with soap (remind kids to shower after sports activities)
Keep cuts and scrapes clean & covered with bandages
Do not share personal items: towels or razors
Report skin lesions to coaches, school nurses, family doctor
